## YOUTH LEAGUES

### Youth League Guidelines

This information pertains to all youth leagues. Please read before registering.

LEAGUES WILL FILL QUICKLY. Register at least one season in advance. If you have questions, comments or concerns please call the Youth Sports Department right away. Please do not wait until the end of the season.

- Registration deadline does not guarantee that there will still be openings.
- All leagues are recreational and considered feeder programs into more competitive leagues in the community. Equal playing time at practices and games.
- When registering you may request a specific coach, or indicate if you would like your child to be on the same team as a sibling or friend. Requests are not guaranteed.
- Past coaches will not be notified each season and coaching spots will not be held. •Parents interested in coaching must go through a coach's screening and a Washington State background check prior to registration. The head coach's child is not charged the league fee, but they must call the Youth Sports Department to register as a coach.
- Fee includes team T-shirt.
- Register your child according to your child's birth date. Ask this question, "How old will my child be at the start date of the league?" Children must play within their age range.
- Mandatory meeting involves meeting the coach, covering league information, distributing team rosters, schedules and T-shirts. You will not receive a reminder. Show up on the date and time listed on your receipt. This is a meeting only, not a practice.
- One-hour practice, one evening a week will be determined by gym/field availability and the coaches. Some leagues, ages seven and older may practice two evenings during the week prior to the first game. Parents may not have input regarding practice times and locations.
- A parent/guardian is required to attend all practices and all games. Children cannot be dropped off.
