

MOTORCYCLE SAFETY CLASSES

All classes are taught on a safe, closed riding course with guidance from our experienced, nationally-certified instructors. We provide a comfortable learning environment for both men and women. Our focus is on helping you successfully develop safe riding habits and life-saving skills.

Starter Rider Session \$99

- 5-hour practice course – motorcycles provided.
- Designed for riders with no experience.
- Build confidence and master excellent basic skills.
- Gain experience and comfort level with motorcycle controls.
- DOES NOT provide a motorcycle endorsement test waiver.

Novice Rider Training

Subsidized*	\$125
Non-subsidized**	\$230

Riders under age 18	\$50

- 17-hour course – motorcycles provided.
- Designed for novice riders and riders returning to the sport.
- Includes both classroom and riding instruction.
- Learn and practice basic skills – without the risk of on-road traffic.
- Learn life-saving techniques for quick

stops, swerving and negotiating curves.

- Earn a waiver of Washington motorcycle endorsement tests after passing course tests.

Additional Rider Session \$69

- 5-hour practice course – motorcycles provided – bargain price.
- For riders who desire more practice after completing the Novice Rider Training.
- Build more confidence and sharpen riding skills.
- DOES NOT provide a motorcycle endorsement test waiver.

Experience Rider Course \$125

- 7-hour course – must bring your own motorcycle.
- Designed for riders who currently own and operate a street-legal motorcycle.
- Ride your own street legal motorcycle (must provide your own bike for this class).
- Practice turning, limited space maneuvers, quick stops, swerving.
- Develop safe riding habits and break bad riding habits.
- Earn a waiver of Washington motorcycle endorsement tests after passing course tests.

Intermediate Rider Course \$149

- Designed for experienced rider off road/dirt, current, past years.
- Ride our trainer bikes in class.
- Provides a Washington motorcycle endorsement test waiver to riders who

pass the written and skills test.

- Riders must demonstrate riding skills overall control of the motorcycle at the beginning of course.

Advanced Experienced Rider \$125

- 9-hour course – motorcycle endorsement required. This is the next step for riders who have completed the Intermediate Rider Course.
- Designed for endorsed, experienced riders who have solid basic skills.
- Ride your own street-legal motorcycle (must provide your own bike for this class).
- Concentrated toward self-assessment, risk-taking behaviors and riding strategies.
- Skill development focuses on advanced braking, cornering and swerving.
- DOES NOT provide a motorcycle endorsement test waiver.

*Subsidized: Washington residents pay a lower price for subsidized classes. The State of Washington subsidizes only a limited number of courses per year throughout the state. Any Washington resident or active military (stationed in Washington) is qualified to take the subsidized Novice Rider Training. You MUST present valid photo ID as proof of residency.

**Non-subsidized: In order to better serve our customers, we have added non-subsidized classes to the schedule. The classes are more expensive but the waiting period is usually much shorter than that of subsidized classes.
