All classes are taught on a safe, closed riding course with guidance from our experienced, nationally certified instructors. We provide a comfortable learning environment for both men and women. Our focus is on helping you successfully develop safe riding habits and life-saving skills.



- Starter Rider Session \$99**
- Five-hour course – motorcycles provided.
 - Designed for riders with little or no experience.
 - Build confidence and master basic skills.
 - Gain experience with control identification and usage, clutch control, straight line riding, stopping and turning.
 - DOES NOT provide a motorcycle endorsement test waiver.

- Novice Rider Training**

- 17-hour course – motorcycles provided.
 - Designed for novice riders and riders returning to the sport.
 - Includes both classroom and range instruction.
 - Gain experience with control usage, clutch control, straight line riding, stopping, turning, and limited space maneuvers.
 - Learn life-saving techniques for quick stops, swerving and negotiating curves.
 - Provides a Washington motorcycle endorsement test waiver to students who pass the written and skills test.

- Additional Rider Session \$69**
- Five-hour course – motorcycles provided
 - Designed for riders that desire additional practice after completing the NRT.
 - Gain more experience with clutch control, straight line riding, stopping, turning, limited space maneuvers, quick stops, swerving and negotiating curves.
 - DOES NOT provide a motorcycle endorsement test waiver.

- Intermediate Rider Training \$125**
- Seven-hour course – must bring your own motorcycle.
 - Designed for riders who currently own and operate a street-legal motorcycle.
 - Students ride their own motorcycles (motorcycles must pass a safety inspection prior to being ridden in class).
 - Gain more experience with turning, limited space maneuvers, quick stops, swerving and negotiating curves.
 - Develop good riding habits and break bad riding habits.
 - Provides a Washington motorcycle endorsement test waiver to students who pass the written and skills test.

- Advanced Experienced Rider \$125**
- Nine-hour course.
 - Designed for endorsed, experienced riders who have solid basic skills.
 - The course complements and enhances skills gained and experienced through other courses.
 - Students ride their own motorcycles (motorcycles must pass a safety inspection prior to being ridden in class).
 - Special emphasis is given to self-assessment, risk taking behaviors and riding strategies.
 - Skill development focuses on advanced braking, cornering and swerving.
 - DOES NOT provide a motorcycle endorsement test waiver.
 - A motorcycle endorsement is required to register for this class.

* Subsidized: Washington residents pay a lower price for subsidized classes. The State of Washington subsidizes only a limited number of courses per year throughout the state. Any Washington resident or active military (stationed in Washington) is qualified to take the subsidized NRT. You MUST present valid photo ID as proof of residency.

** Non-subsidized: In order to better serve our customers, we have added non-subsidized classes to the schedule. The classes are more expensive but the waiting period is usually much shorter than that of subsidized classes.
