

Street Width

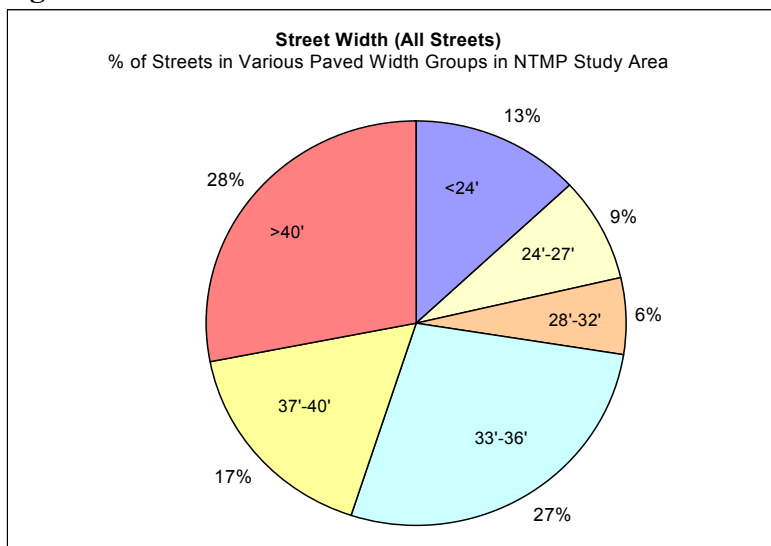


Figure 2-8: SE Vancouver Local Street Widths

Street width data for the SE Vancouver NTMP study area was obtained from the City of Vancouver’s pavement management data. Figure 2-7 shows the distribution of paved width for all of the streets in the study area. Figure 2-8 shows the street width distribution for only local streets in the study area. Both figures indicate that approximately 75 percent of the streets, regardless if they are local or not, are greater than 32 feet in paved width. Typically, streets that are 32 feet or narrower would be considered more characteristic of a neighborhood street. The street width distributions shown in Figures 2-7 and 2-8 indicate that the study area has a large inventory of wide neighborhood streets, a strong contributing factor to issues such as higher vehicle speeds.

Figure 2-7: SE Vancouver Street Widths
